Kathy Roat shared a door hanger and the group discussed using it for outreach regarding memberships and also to Save The Date for future events in WPNA. City needs advance notice to order blank door hangers with perforations.

Police reports were discussed. Traffic safety was discussed Chris LoRang shared "Do people feel safe?" He meets with a safety person from Des Moines Police regarding pedestrian/vehicle safety.

Chris also reported regarding Recreation Districts in the city. Suggested that city meet with MidAmerican for questions and expectation. 20% of cost from MidAmerican suggested.

Porch Fest Committee revisited: Tim Earp, Heidi and Mike Pullmann, John Smith, Jenna Borcherding. Not sure about this year. Last year's date was September 10th. Do we join to support or have a different time? Ingersoll Live, Beaverdale Fall Fest, Homecoming, Iowa vs Iowa State, and other local events during that time.

Chamberlain Triangle Project – Tory Rowley reported on the meeting she and David had with Principal Steve Schappaugh of Roosevelt High School in support of de-escalation with students on the triangle at Chamberlain and California Circle. Creating a positive neighborhood presence and making it a place for good things to happen.

Tory Rowley met with the people who coordinated the triangle across from Black Cat Ice Cream. They worked with the city and got support from Invest DSM. Their project involved fund raising of \$10,000 and involved fund raising and administrative talents by a team. John Smith added that he was on the Drake board at that time, and it took 5-6 years to complete. He was very involved in that project. It did give a sense of place and community.

Julie Snyder brought up the use of the new track at the high school for walkers. Many people want to use it. The school has been contacted about the request, but there has been no response from the Principle. Questions were whether it was a warranty issue that had to do with a condition on the donation of the turf. Is it related to liability for any injuries sustained by community members? Is it a worry about vandalism? Nick Coleman could ask for more information from the Principle, who will be at our meeting in February. (Nick Coleman and Tory Rowley met with Principle Schappaugh in early February)
